Situate in Curru Township Berks County Cont^d A^s 55 1/4
 & the allowance of six p. cent & c^d Surveyed to George Merckel
 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 7 July 1806 [The whole
 survey originally made in pursuance of this warrant (& returned
 in the Surveyor General's Office) contained A^s 85 & the allow^{ce}
 & c^d But by a written agreement since made between the said Geo.
 Merckel & Daniel Pannebecker it was agreed that the above tract
 marked A should be surveyed to the said Daniel Pannebecker
 by virtue of his improvement.] The remainder being the above
 tract of A^s 55 1/4 & the allow^{ce} & c^d is hereby accordingly returned
 for the said George Merckel.
