



A Draught of a tract of land Situate in Reading Township in the County of York Resurveyed by the lines formerly run, the ninth day of April 1791 To Henry Myer in pursuance of two warrants one w<sup>t</sup> bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October 1748 in the name of Daniel Hare - The other in the name of William Melhenny dated the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1754 containing Two hundred and nine acres &  $\frac{2}{8}$  and allowance of Six acres P Cent for roads.
