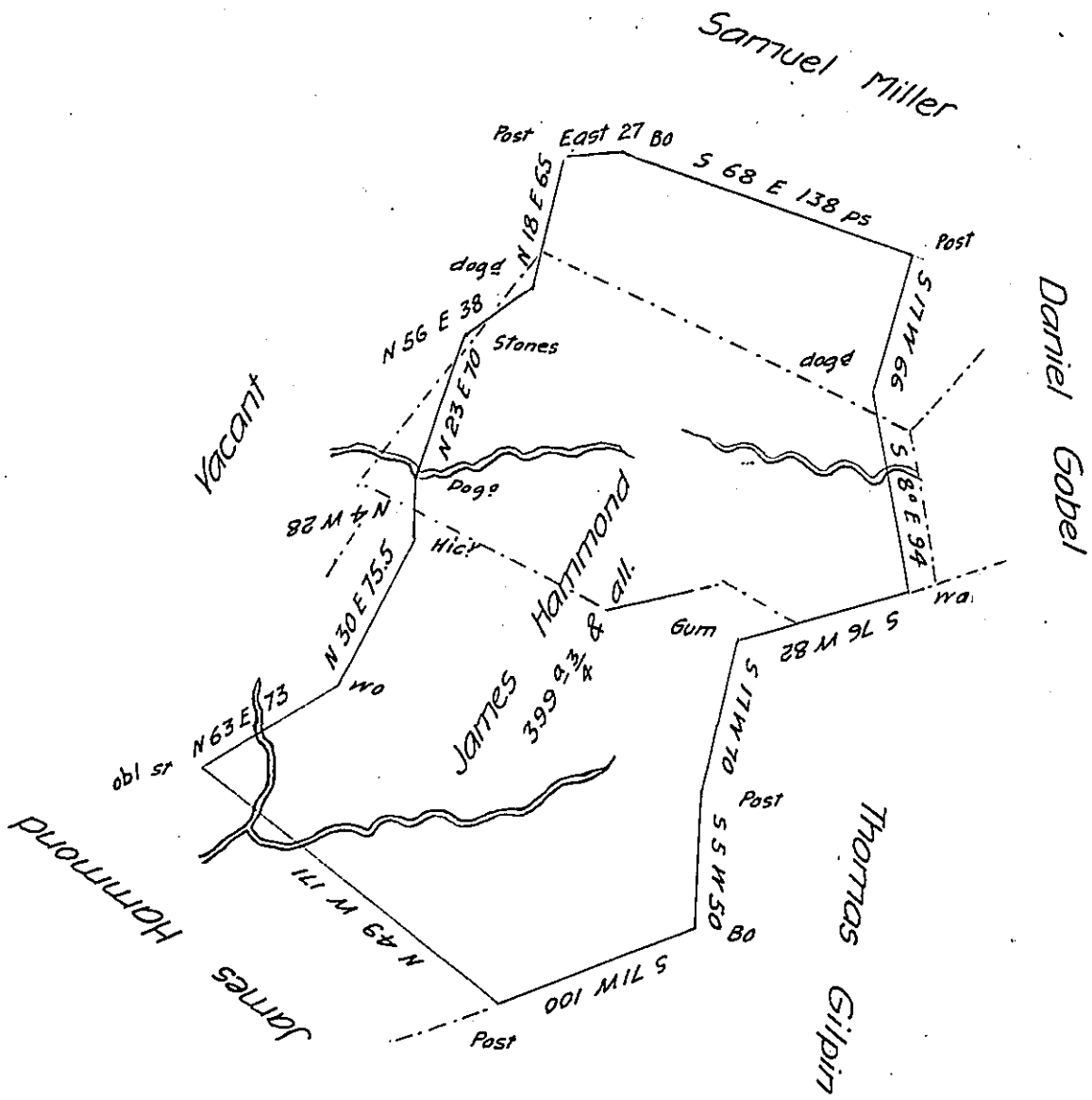


Note, the dotted lines represent the interference of Jno McKim alluded to in McKims return.
