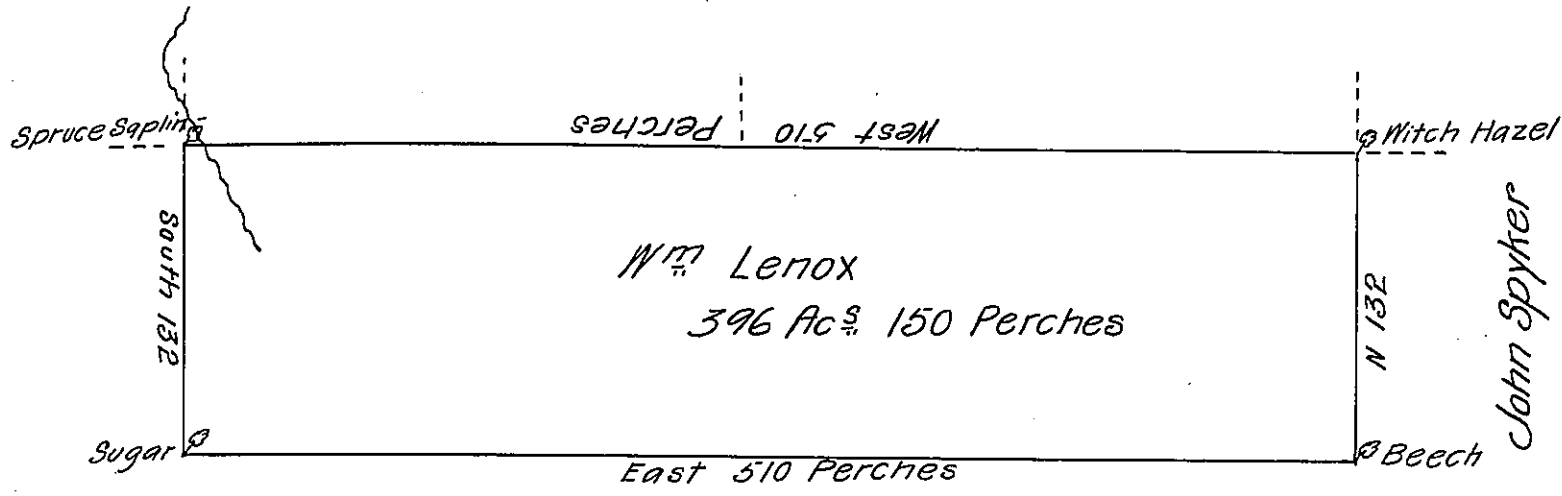


Rosannah Vancamp Benjn Brown
