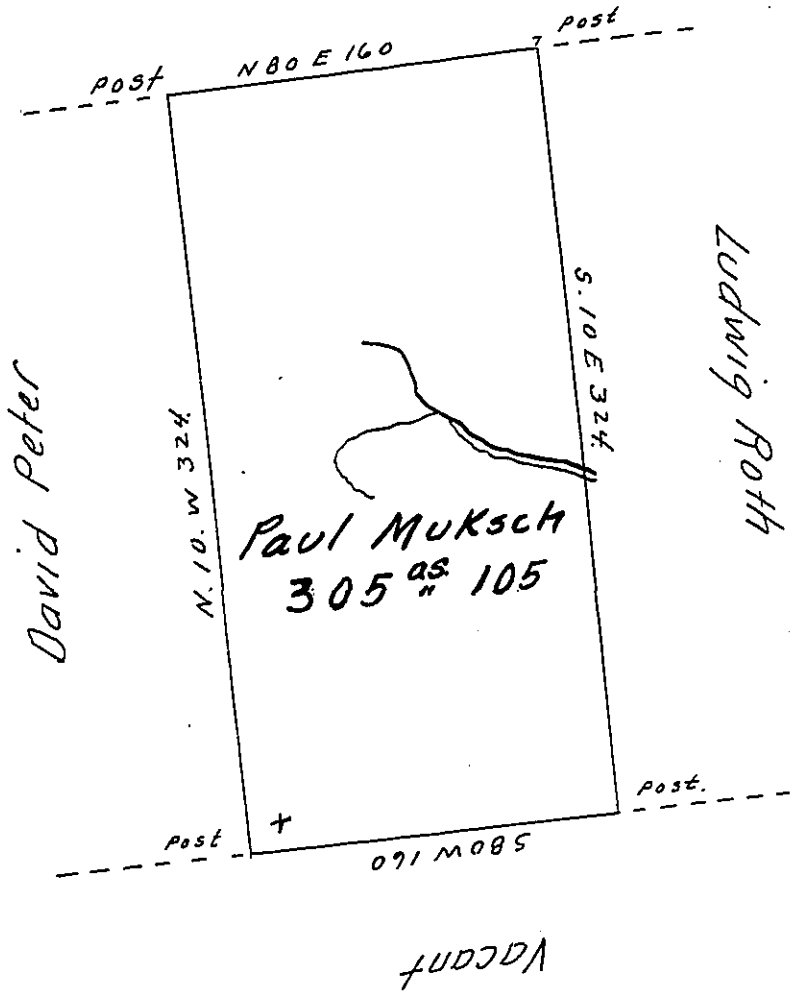

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> March 1789. Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> May 1789 to Paul MUKSCH the above described Tract of Land situate on the Head Waters of Hazelswamp Creek and near the Heads of Cramberry Creek a Branch of Black Creek in the County of Northampton Containing Three hundred and five Acres One Hundred & five Perches & the Allowance of six per Cent &c.
