



The above is a draught of a Survey made the 13th day Of February Anno domini 1794. In pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners appointed by the State Of Virginia to Settle Claims of unpotented lands in the Countys of Yohogany, Monongahaly and Ohio to John St. Clair which Certificate I find entered by Robert Woods Surveyor of Ohio County on the 7th day of March Anno Domini 1780. Situated on the waters of buffelow Creek in the County of Washington. Containing Two Hundred and Twenty two acres one Rood & Nineteen perches.
