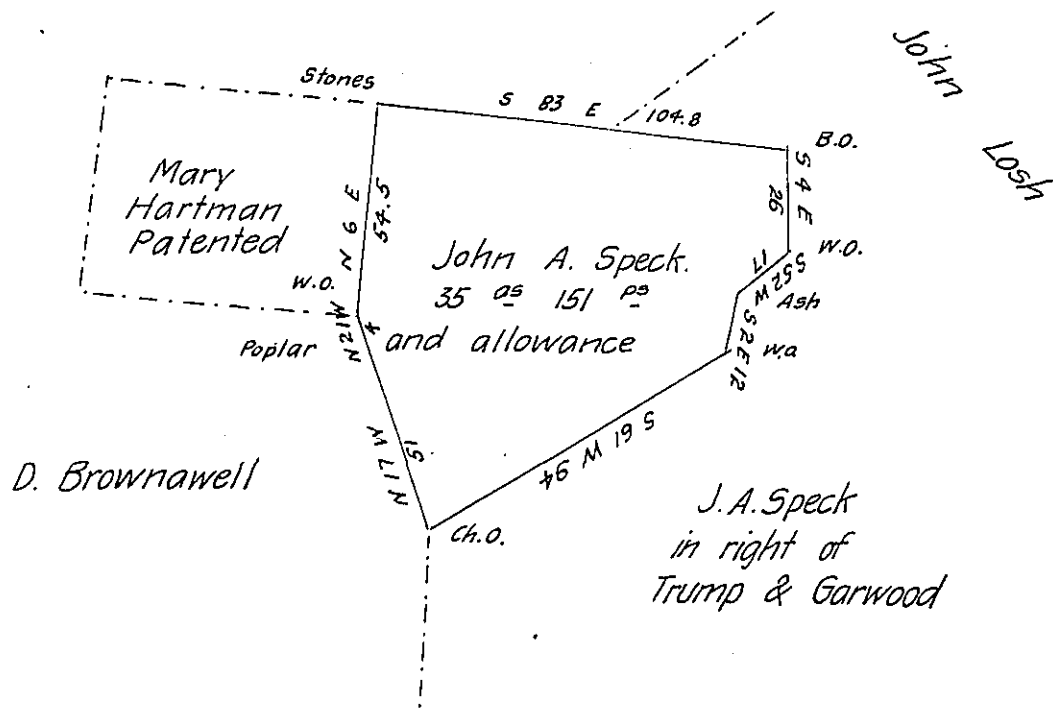


J. A. Speck.
