being the 5<sup>th</sup> Survey Westward of the Division Line  
of said District and No 2 in the 5<sup>th</sup> Parallel South of  
the 3<sup>d</sup> 4 miles Square from the Northern Boundary  
of that Tract of Country appropriated by law for  
the Redemption of the Certificates of Depreciation  
&c and Surveyed in the Month of June 1785 pur-  
suant to Instructions from John Lukens Esq.  
Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania
