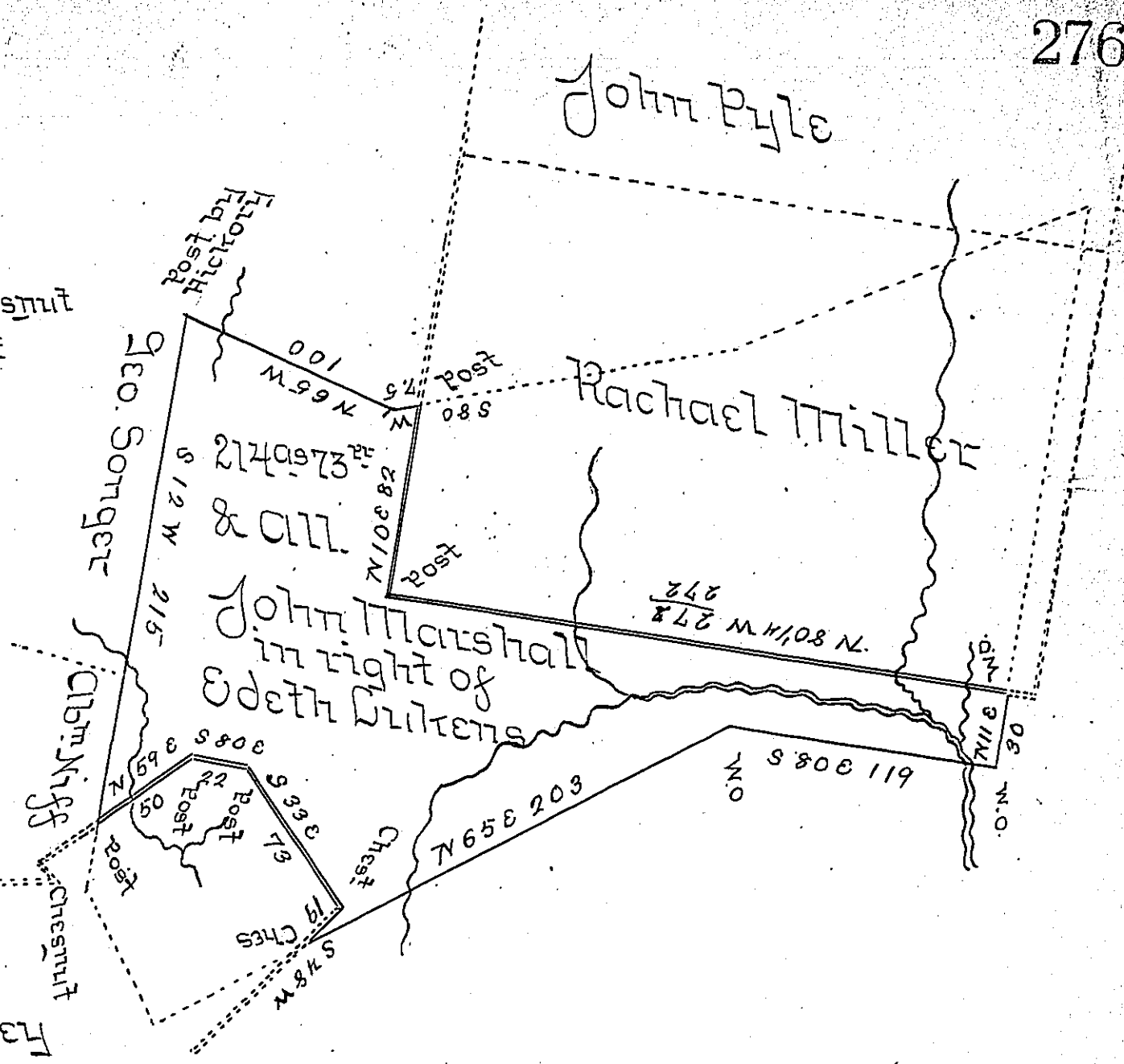

Situate in Hepburn Township Lycoming County & bounded as above.
