

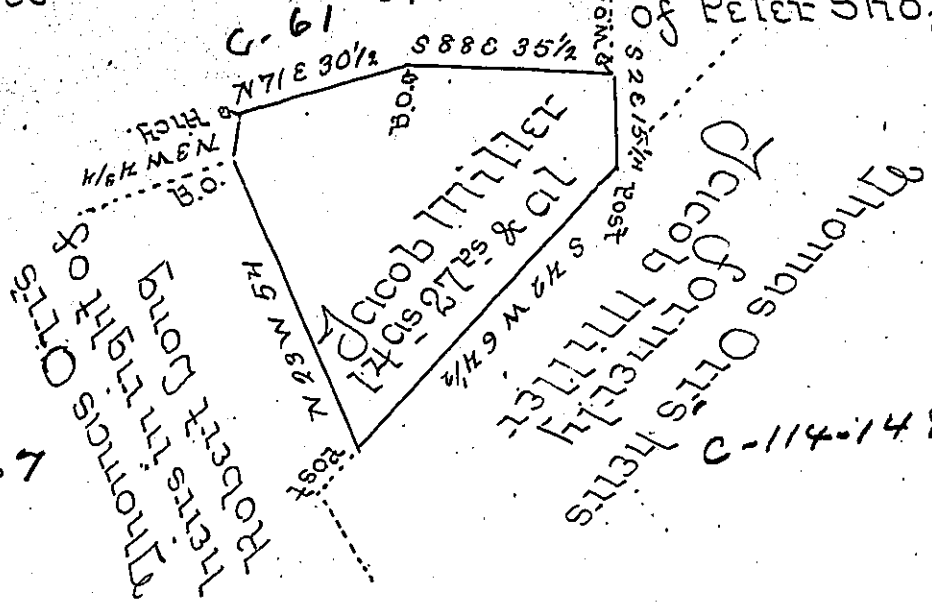

 ship Franklin County containing fourteen Acres twenty seven  
 perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Resurveyed 25-Nov-  
 ember 1628 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property  
 for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating  
 to unpatented lands under Proprietary rights &c and by  
 virtue of a Warrant dated 3<sup>d</sup> June 1775 granted to Jacob Mil-  
 ler for 70 Acres joining his other land Jacob Weitzle Peter  
 Shoff and John Finley in Surquin Township Resurvey'd agree-  
 able to lines Survey'd 26-Nov-1773 for Jacob Miller  
 by Jacob Spangler Esq<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> S. Davis } Contractors

Note A Survey of 72<sup>a</sup> 5<sup>p</sup>s & all<sup>e</sup> was made on the 15 Aug<sup>t</sup>  
 1791 & returned on the above Warrant, which survey  
 interfered with a Tract held on a Warrant to John  
 Finley dated 15-Dec-1752; But in pursuance of an Order  
 of the Board of Property dated 27-Mar-1792 a Resurvey  
 was made 10-Mar-1812 on Finley's Warrant - taking  
 in the land which had been in dispute; which Sur-  
 vey was Confirmed <sup>by Patent</sup> on Finley's Warrant - leaving the  
 Survey on Miller's Warrant in its Original Form  
 as now returned; W.S.D.
