



Contention is a Draft of a tract of land lying West of the Ohio River in Allegheny County now Beaver Surveyed December 11th 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Neal McLaughlin dated May 16th 1793 containing 395 Acres & 90 perches and allowance of 6 per Cent for roads &c. I Hugh McCallough US do hereby Officially certify that in Obedience to your Order I surveyed the Above Tract March 6th 1816 and corrected two errors on the ground the above is a correct Draft of said land on which Neal McLaughlin actually resides
