



The above described tract of land was surveyed on the 5th day of September 1798 by Henry Donnel then deputy for William Moor by virtue of his Warrant Dated the 23^d March 1796 and at the request of W^m Moor, surveyed this 5th day of January 1816 containing one hundred & eight acres & one hundred and fifty six perch with the allowance of six percent for Roads Situate on White Deer hole Creek in Washington Township Susquehanna County and bounded as above Note the improvements are about fifty Acres cleared two small houses with families therein two Barns & Saw Mill
