



A draft of two connected tracts of land situate in Franklin township Montour County. The largest one surveyed to Abram Lillie the twenty fourth day of October 1851 by virtue of his Warrant dated the 20th day of October 1851. Containing Twenty four Acres & Sixty four perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. about one and a fourth acres improved in the tract. The smallest tract surveyed to Aaron Lamberson by virtue of his Warrant dated the 20th day of October 1851 on the twenty fourth day of October 1851. Containing Eight acres & One hundred & Twenty six perches & the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. On this tract there is about six & a fourth acres improved with house & barn thereon.
