



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> January 1801 surveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> June 1801 to the Heirs of David Leist the above described tract of Land situate in Upper Mount Bethel township Northampton County containing two hundred and thirty-one acres sixty perches and allowance of six p. Cent. & ca.
