



The Draft of a Tract of Land situate in West Buffalo township Union County surveyed the 17 day of April Anno Dom 1822 for Christian Kaup, containing sixty nine acres and one hundred and ten perches with the usual allowance of six pr. Cent & c. It being part of a Tract of Land surveyed the 16 day of April A. D. 1800 for Samuel Wright, James Wright and William Wright Executors of the Last Will & Testament of John Loudon late of the County aforesaid deceased in pursuance of a Warrant for 250 acres of Land granted to John Loudon bearing date the 15 January A. D. 1793 containing two hundred and seventy one acres & one hundred and four perches with the usual allowance of six pr. Cent & c.
