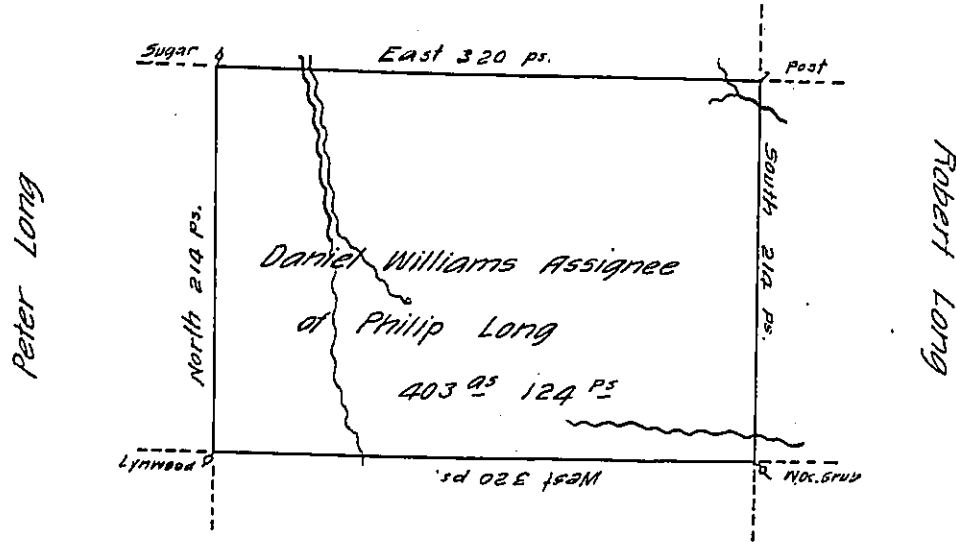

In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1793 was surveyed for Daniel Williams Assignee of Philip Long the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 1817, the above described Tract of Land containing 403<sup>95</sup> 124 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads & c. Situate in Sadsbury Township Crawford County and at the time of making said survey, the said Daniel Williams was actually Residing on the same with his family and had a House fit for the habitation of man and there appeared to have been cleared and fenced upwards of ten acres of Land
