



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Lawson Bearing date March 9th 1789, the above discribed tract of Land containing three hundred thirty acres one hundred thirty-four perches & allowance proportioned at six per Cent for Roads & c. Situate in Fairfield Township in the County of Westmoreland, was surveyed on the 9th day of May 1789, By John Moore then deputy Surveyor taken from his draft of the same now remaining in my office which I have examined and find aparantly correct Certified this 10th day of July 1815.
