



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the Thirty first day of ~~August~~ ^{July} 1734 Surveyed unto Hans Moyer a tract of Land Situate in the Township of Safford in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a white Oak a Corner of his other Land thence by y^e same South West forty Eight perches to a post thence by s^d Land South East Twenty seven perches to a post thence by y^e same Land South West Seventy-Six perches to a post in the line of Derick Jonson's Land thence by y^e same North West one hundred and seventeen perches to a post near a marked Hickery being a Corner of s^d Jonson's Land thence by land of Andreas Hawk North East one Hundred perches and y^e same course by Vacant Land Twenty four perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South East ninety perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing Seventy Seven Acres & Three Quarters of an Acre with the usual allowance of Six $\frac{1}{4}$ Cent.
