



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated Ninth day of December 1734 Surveyed unto Adam Moser a tract of Land Situate in the County of Philada. beginning at a post a corner of his other Land thence by the same North forty degrees East one hundred and Seventy five perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South fifty degrees East Seventy two perches to a Small hickery Sapling thence by Vacant Land South forty degrees West one hundred and Eighty two perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North West fifteen perches & by land of Richard Gregory fifty seven perches to the place of Beginning Containing Seventy five acres with the Usual Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. Surveyed December 18th 1734.
