



Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York and Containing as above set forth 86° 94 p. & allowance. Being part of a larger tract of land originally Surveyed for Zachariah Shugart in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James McVoy. Bearing date the 23rd of Dec: 1766 Divided off from the said larger tract on the 29th of the 5th mo 1776 by William Kersey. And now after having been carefully examined Corrected and Calculated, it is, at the request of the present Owner, Adam Fry, returned for Confirmation the 10th day of August Anno Domini 1809.
