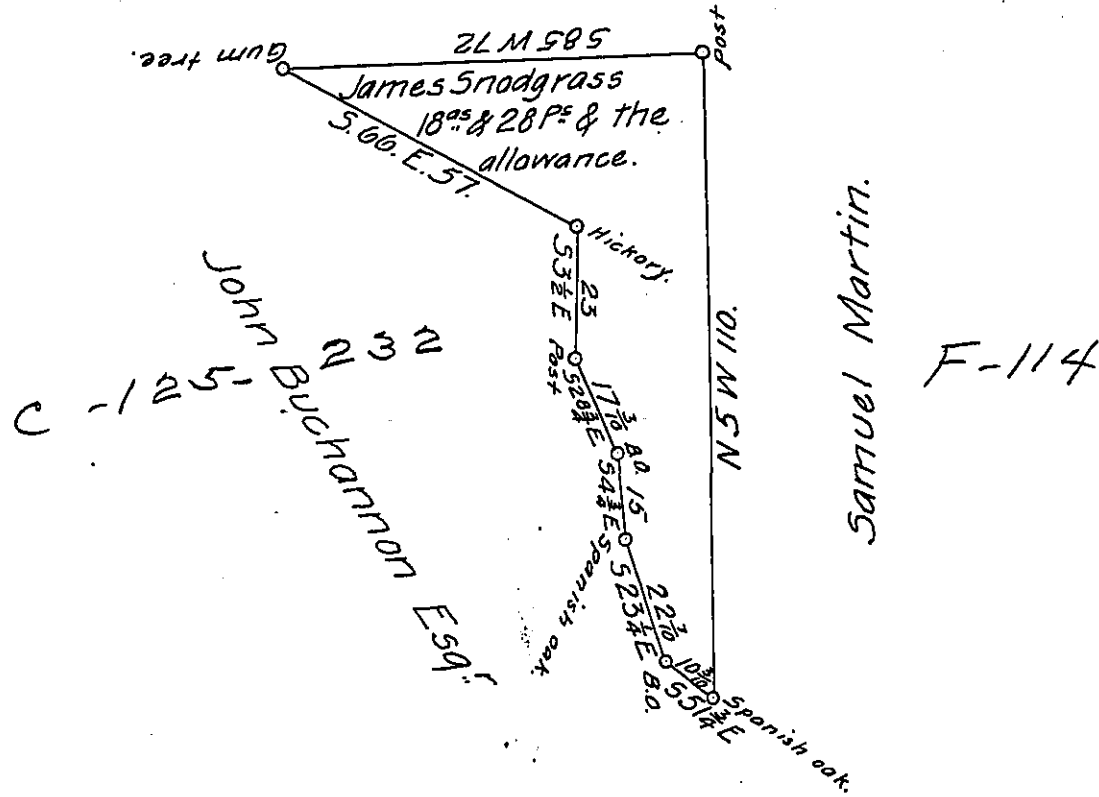


James Snodgrass.
