



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 11<sup>1/2</sup> & 143 Perches & allowance, Being part of a Larger Tract of Land which was originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 4<sup>th</sup> mo. 2<sup>d</sup> 1794 In pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>ac</sup> Granted to David Morgan bearing date the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1743/4. Divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1806 and now at the request of the present owner John Keener, I am desired to make Return of the Draught as Calculated, examined and Corrected the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1809.
