



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing Date the twenty eighth Day of May Anno Dom^o 1741 I have Survey'd and Laid out unto Robert Moore on Conewaga Creek in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna river Three hundred and Sixty acres of Land with Allowance of Six P. Cent Beginning at a Maple a Corn^{er} of Solomon Shepherds Land Thence North twenty six Degrees Westerly one hundred and forty Pches to a Hick Thence North Sixty four Degrees Easterly Eighty Pches to a white Oak Thence North twenty Six Degrees Westerly Three hundred and Nineteen Pches to a White Oak Thence South Sixty four Degrees Westerly Seventy Eight Pches to a white Oak Thence South fourteen Degrees Westerly Two hundred and Ninety four Pches to a Spanish Oak by the Said Creek Thence Down the Same Traversing the Several Courses thereof Near about a mile to the place of Beginning
