



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on Pigeon Creek in Washington County, called Woodstock Containing 364 Acres 2 Roods 19 Perches Surveyed February the 26th 1785 in Pursuance of a Certificate from the Commissioners of Virginia for a Settlement Right as followith to wit:

We the Commissioners Apointed to Adjust titles to un patten^d Lands in Counties of Monongahela Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Christian Leatherman is Intitled to four hundred Acres of Land to Include his Settlement Made on the waters of Pigeon Creek made in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy four also a right in p^remption to one thousand Acres of Land Adjoining thereto

Given under our hands at Coxes Fort the Eighteenth day of February 1780 In the fourth year of the Common Wealth
