Surveyed on the 8 day of September 1775 by William Maclay then Deputy and Resurveyed on the 2 day of May 1808 agreeable to the Old lines for James McClanahan by Virtue of his Warrant bearing date on the 28 day of November 1774 Containing two hundred and fourteen Acres with the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent.
