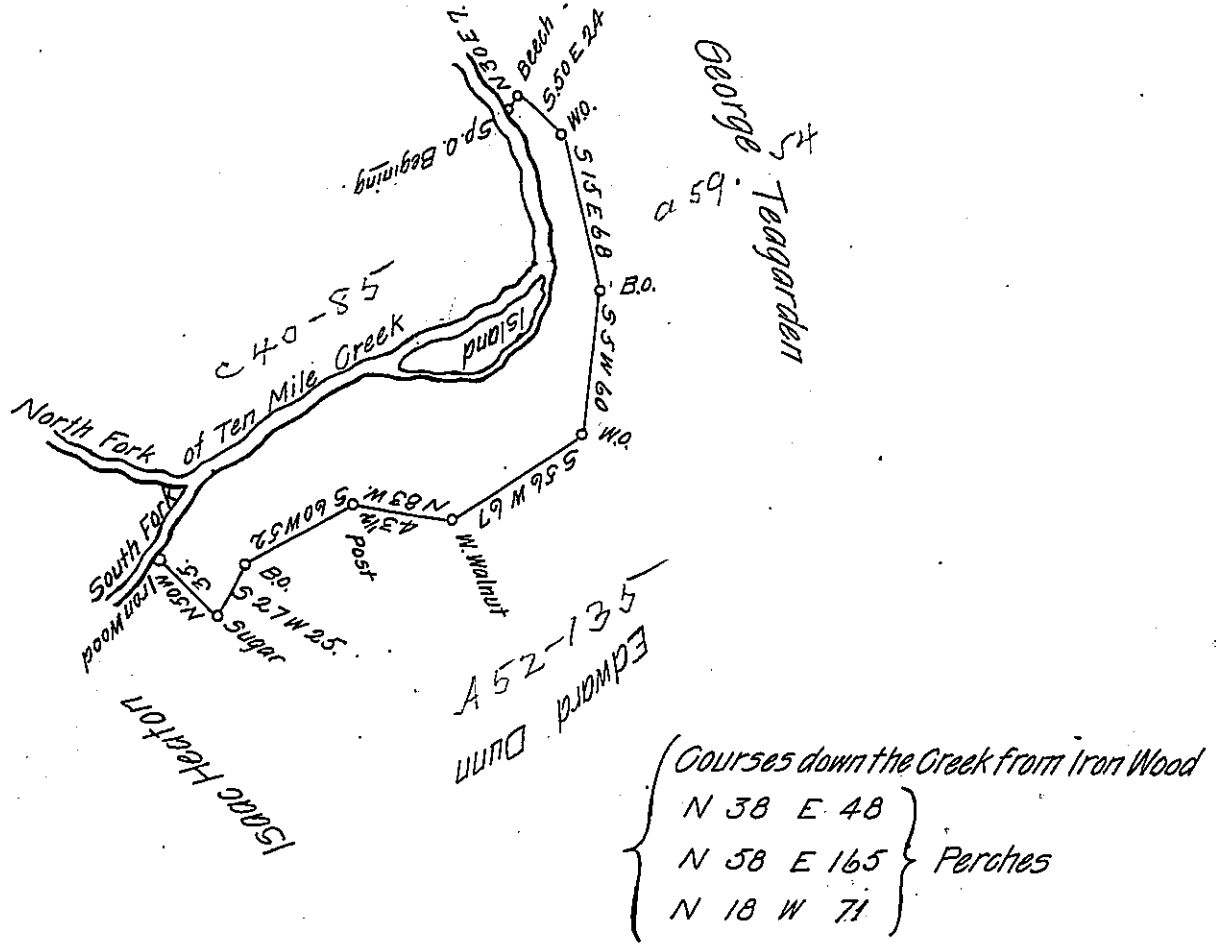


No Vacant Land between "Cedar Hill" & "Grove" Surv't Patents
