Being part of a larger tract said to contain 52^a & all^{ce} Surveyed August 14th 1790 by John Forsythe D.S. by warrant to Henry Mull dated May 28th 1763. and now found to contain 50^a 87^{ps} & all^{ce}. Divided from the residue August 28th 1811 for Ludwick Myers containing twenty acres thirteen perches & all^{ce}.

B. Being part of a larger tract said to contain 49^a 59^{ps} & all. Surveyed August 23rd 1791 by warrant to Henry Mull Dated June 9th 1763. Divided from the residue August 28th 1811 for Ludwick Myers containing ten acres one hundred & five perches & all.
