



The above is the Draught of a Parcel of Land Survey'd the 12th day of the 3rd month (March) 1752, at the desire of John Scott the Possessor thereof at that Time, being the North Wester most Part of an Original Tract Called Budd's Tract, or Milcom Island; this was computed at 53 acres of Land and bounded on the several Courses of Little Cananawago, - Situate in Little Britain Town P. Lancaster County, Laid down by a Scale of 40 per^s to Inch; Copied for Robert Campbel, who is now in Possession of the Land, this 9th of the 9th month 1785. from the former Notes of the Survey.
