



A Draught of a tract of Land surveyed the 26th day of March 1805 by virtue of a Warrant of re-survey Granted to Samuel McConaghey, dated March 6th 1804 Situate in Buffaloe Township on the Waters of Buffaloe Creek in Washington County called Mount Safety Containing two hundred eighty four acres one hundred forty six perches together with the usual allowance of six PERCENT for Roads.
