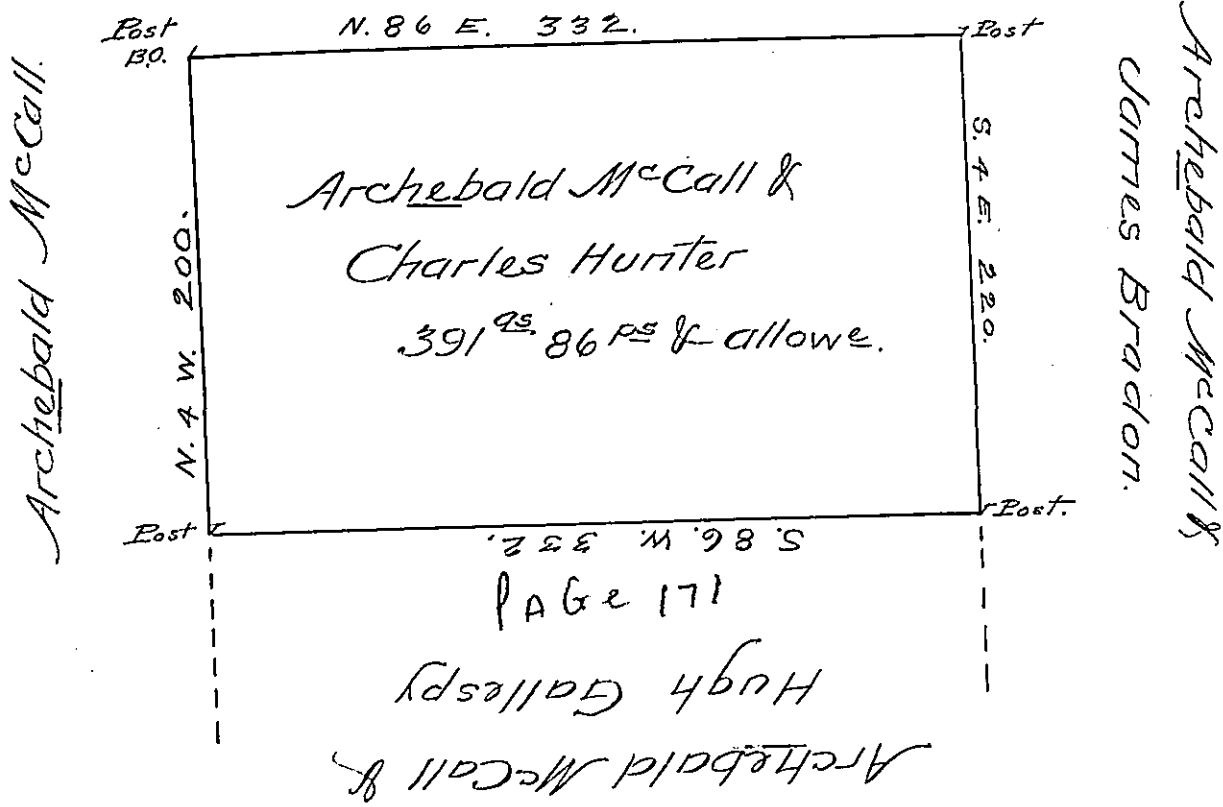


Archibald McCall &

The above is a Draught of a tract of Land which was Surveyed to Archibald McCall & Charles Hunter on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1805 - by virtue of their Warrant dated July 10<sup>th</sup> 1805 Containing three Hundred and ninety one acres & 86 P and allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Ct. - Including their actual Settlement and Improvement - Situate on the waters of Buffalo Creek in Butler County -
