Surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Morgan for 150<sup>2</sup> dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of October 1744 and by virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property Now owned and occupied by Jacob Bowman.
