



A Draught of a Tract of land called the Sink Holes situate on the Path leading from Standing Stone to Frankstown near four Miles above the Fox Tavern including a sinking spring called the Poplar Spring adjoining Land of Martin Lawman & others in Barre Township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred & forty one Acres and the usual Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 13th Day of November 1773 for George Meyer in Purvuance of a Warrant Dated the 25th Day of June in the same year.
