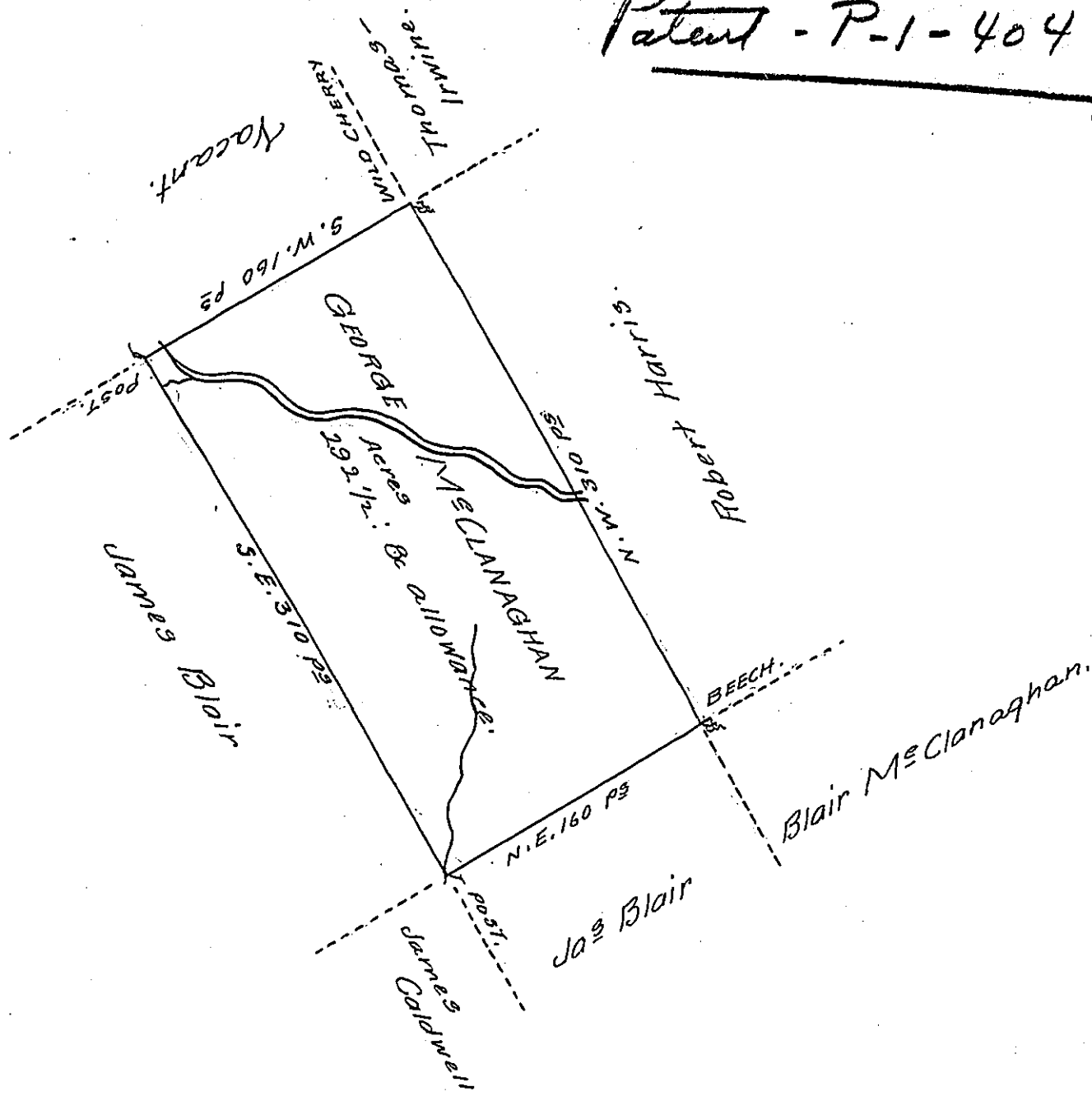


Patent - P-1-404 95
