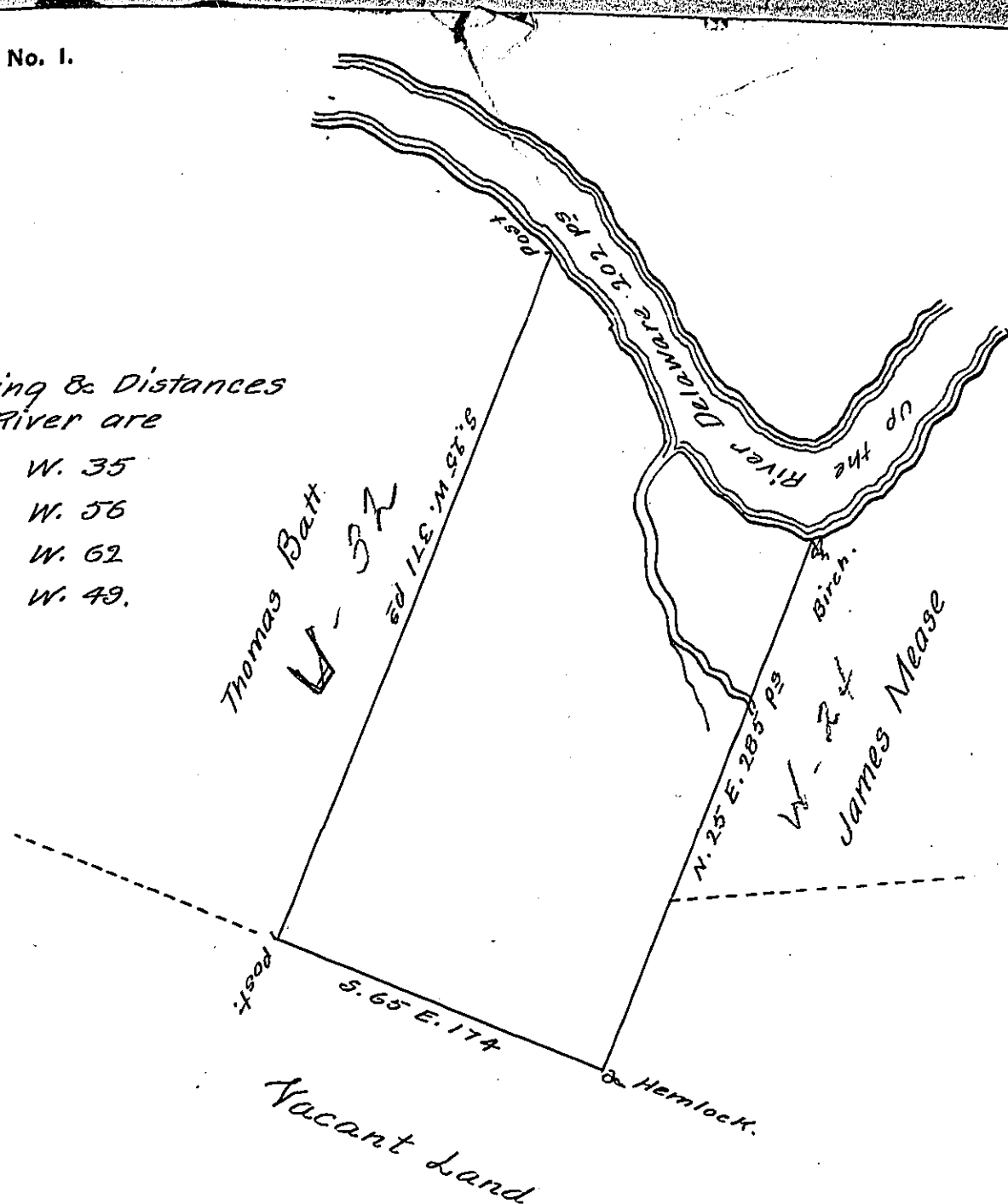


The bearing & Distances
