



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the
 the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for the
 Rev^d John Elder on a certain Lot of ground situate in the Town of Sunbury
 in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said
 Town Number One Hundred and Seventy Seven, Containing in Brea-
 dth East and West on Blackberry Street sixty feet & in Length
 North and South Two Hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Southwa-
 rd by Blackberry Street, Eastward by River Street, Northward by
 Barberry alley and Westward by Lot Number One hund and Seventy
 Eight, Returnd into the Secretaries Office the 19th day of Sept^r 1776
 for Nicholas Miller.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
 the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
