



By virtue of an order to me Directed by Jno Lukens Esq^r S.G. bearing date the 2nd Decem^r 1783 In Pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property have Surveyed unto William Mc Cleary the above Described Tract of Land situate in West Fallowfield or Oxford Townships Chester County in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Mc Keene, having excluded the Land within Mc Cleary's Survey which George Cochran has recovered of him in an action in Chester Court. The Red Lines dividing between Mc Cleary & Cochrans is run & marked agreeable to the present Situation of the Needle, Variation two degrees & a half. the Small piece of Vacant Land above noted, not taken in Mc Clearys former Survey, have Included in the above Survey.
