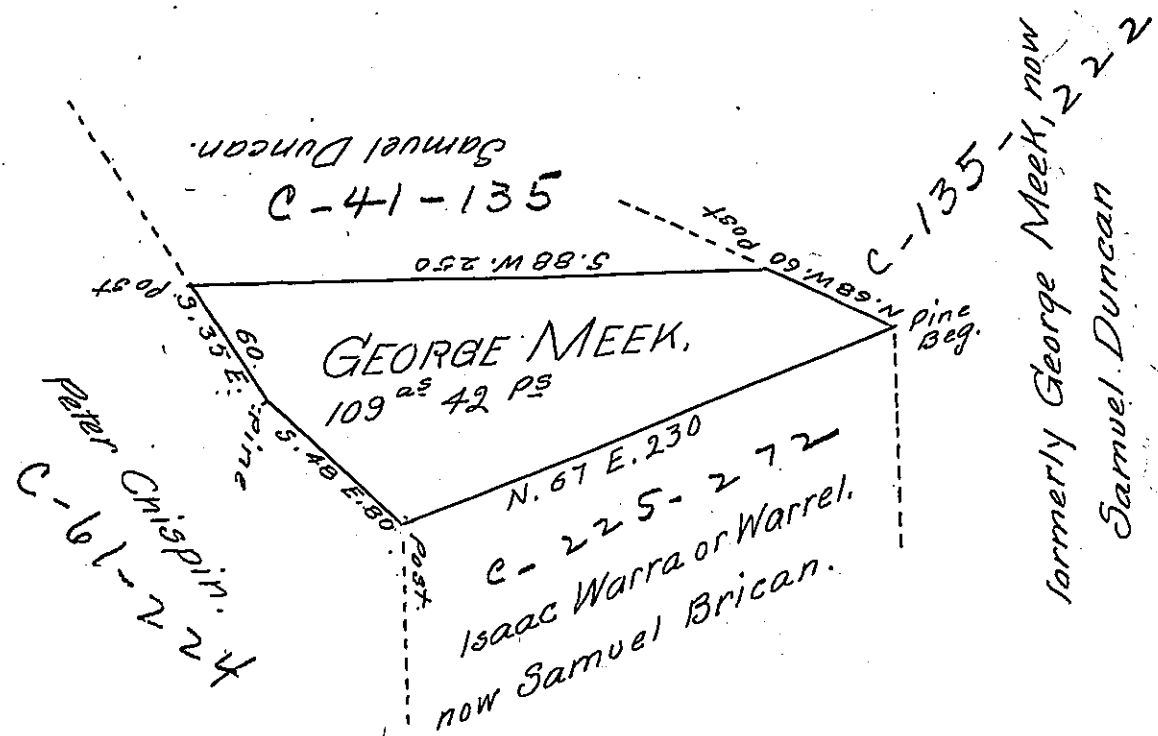

The Draught of a tract of land situate formerly in Franklin, now Ferguson Township Centre County Containing one hundred and nine acres, forty two perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c^{ca} Surveyed the fourth day of November 1812 In pursuance of a warrant granted to George Meek dated the 13th day of March 1797,

The above survey includes an improvement, consisting of a Cabin, House & Stable, and about ten or twelve acres of Cleared land, said to be first ~~do~~ made in Nov^r 1793 and a family now residing on the same under Samuel Duncan.
