The above described tract of land was surveyed to John Miller on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795 In pursuance of a warrant bearing date March 1<sup>st</sup> 1794 by John Moor Esq<sup>r</sup> former Deputy Surveyor, containing Three hundred and Sixteen - acres & One hundred and Thirty six perches with an allowance of six per Cent &c. Situate N.W. of the Allegeny river on the waters of Buffaloe - and adjoining lands Warranted in the name of James Miller on the East, the depreciation & Donation line on the South John Chambers on the West & others Sugar Creek Township Armstrong County - Taken from said Moors<sup>draft</sup> which is now in my possession which I have examined and find<sup>it</sup> to be correct.
