



A Draught of a lot of ground situate in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland, marked in the general Plan of said Town, Number Three hundred and one, Situate on the North side of High Street, Containing in breadth on High Street, East & West Sixty feet; and in length North & South Two hundred and forty feet, Bounded Southward by High Street aforesaid, Westward by lot Number Two hundred and Ninety three, Northward by a Twenty feet Alley; & Eastward by Lot Number Three hundred & Nine, Returned into the Secretary's Office the 28<sup>th</sup> day of November 1776, for Charles McClure, by Warr<sup>t</sup> Dated the 27<sup>th</sup> of November 1776
