



Draught of three hundred and twenty two acres and one hundred and seven perches of land with six per Cent for Roads situate late Derry now Decater township in Mifflin County Surveyed 26th April 1815 in pursuance of a Warrant to James McComaghy dated 15th March 1815. Note there was a family living on the above represented land at time of Survey and I think twenty acres in Cultivation
