



The above is a draft of a tract of land situate in Wolfcreek Township, Mercer County, being part of a larger tract embracing the Claim of the Heirs of Samuel Campbell surveyed the 10th day of May 1831. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Magee the fifth day of April 1831, and reduced the 13th day of Novr 1832. Bounded as above described; Containing two hundred fifty three acres, eighty five perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads. The parallelogram on the South west corner was rejected by David Robeson as useless. Said Robeson was a chain carrier in making this survey.
