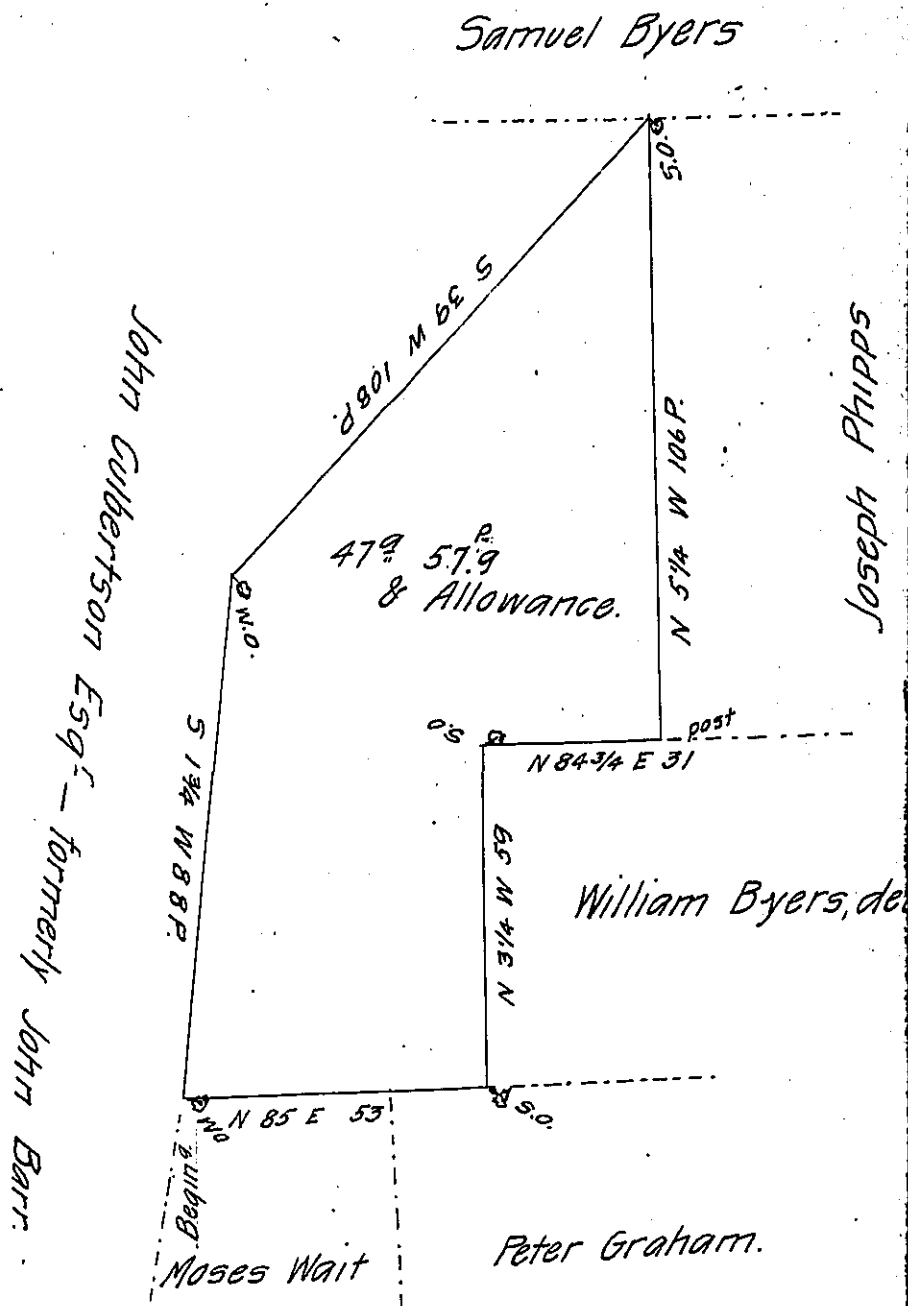


By Virtue of a location N^o 1105
