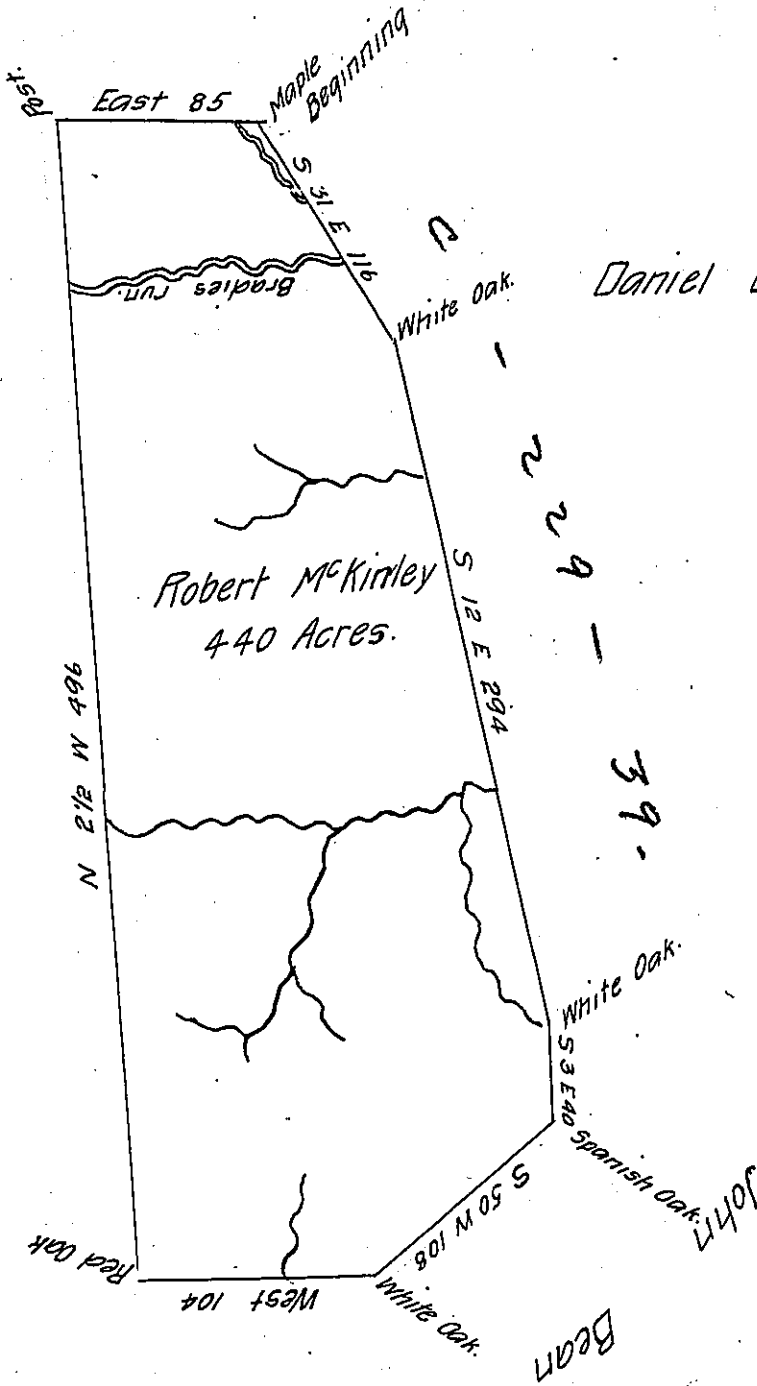

A Draught of a tract of Land Surveyed November the 24th day 1793 for Robert McKinley In pursuance of his Warrant for 400 Acres of land dated the 5th day of June 1792 Situate North and West of the River Ohio and Allegheny and Conowango Creek on the west side of Big Beaver Creek on the the waters of Broddies run commonly known by the name of Captain Racoons old Dwelling, in the County of Allegheny Called Hickory Flat Containing four hundred and forty Acres & the Usual Allowance of Six p^c Cent for for Roads & high ways.
