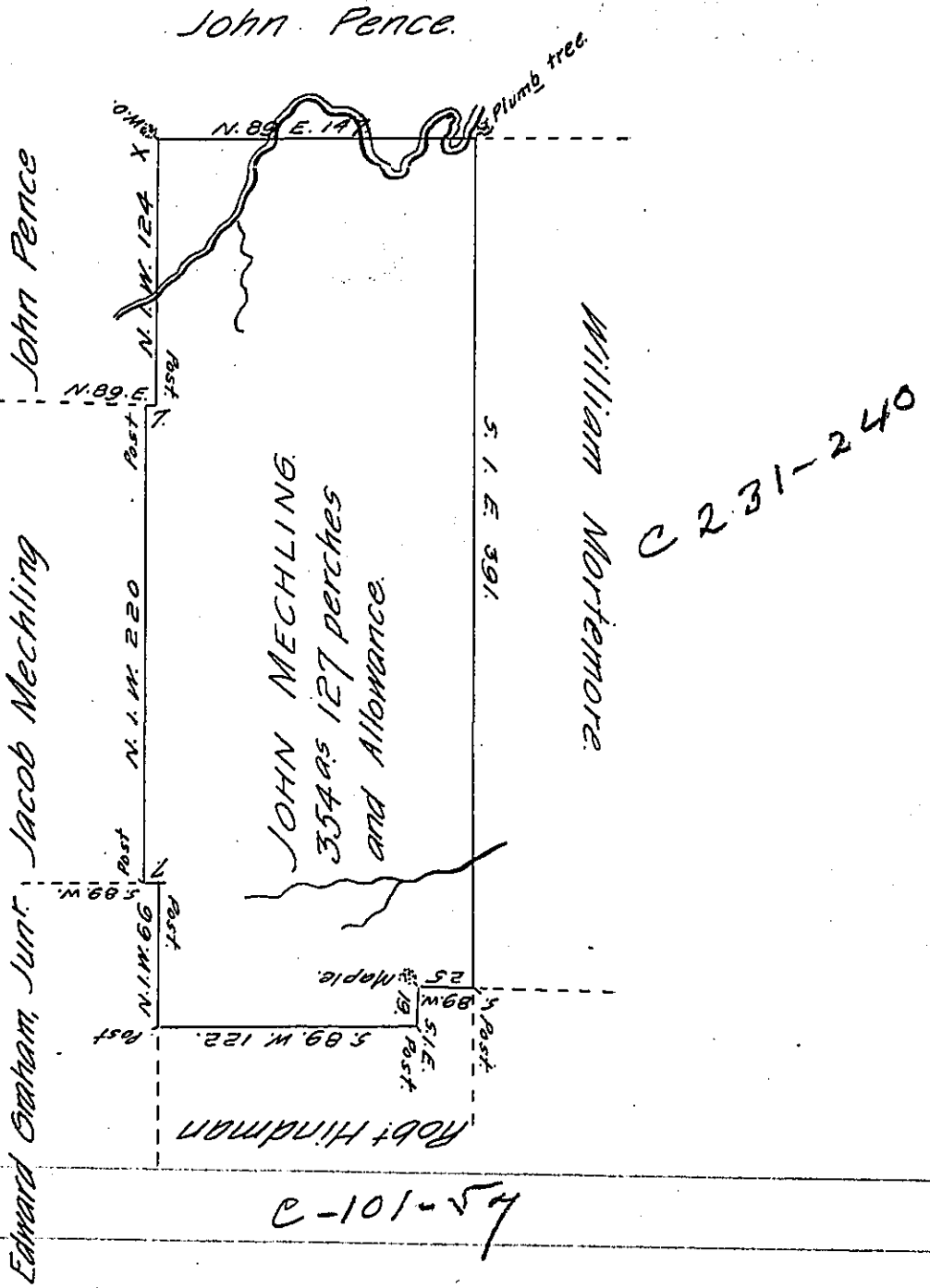

Containing three Hundred and fifty four Acres and 127 perches and Allowance of Six per Cent 8^c including his Actual Settlement and Improvement, Situate on the waters of Bare Creek, in Parker Township and Butler County.
