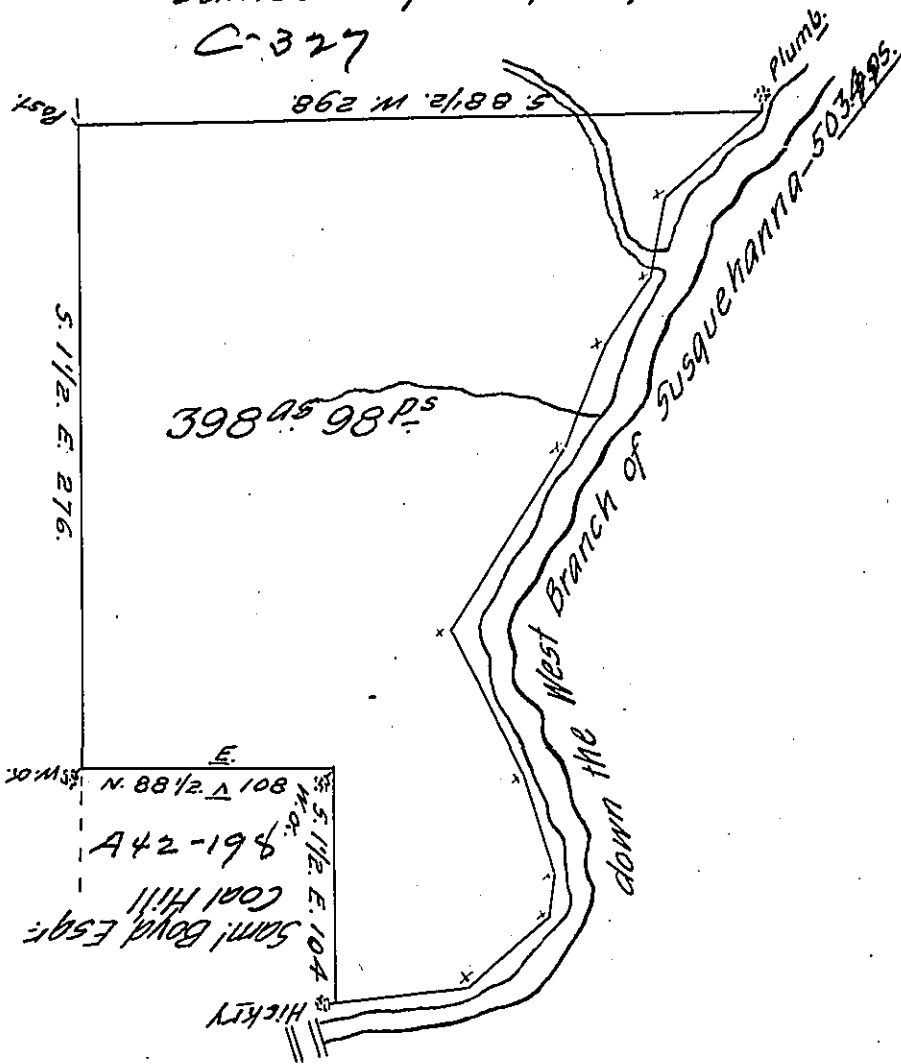

The above Draft of a Tract of Land Containing three hundred ninety eight Acres, ninety eight perches and Allowance of Six p^c Cent for Roads, was originally surveyed to the Rev^d William Marshal in pursuance of his Lottery Warrant N^o 28, dated the 17th Day of May 1785, Situate in the late Purchase East side of Allegheny River, now in Clearfield County and opposite the Town of Clearfield, on the West Bank of Susquehanna.

The lines of which Tract was resurveyed, examined and Corrected on the first Day of November 1806, in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property, dated the 30 November 1804.
