



A Draught of an Island in the river Susquehanna, Manor Township, in the County of Lancaster, opposite the lands of Daniel Mendig on the Lancaster-Shore, near the middle of the river, and about Five Yards above the Ridge Island. Called "High Ridge Island," Containing 3 acres and 80 Square perches, neat measure. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 4th day of December Anno Domini 1834, granted to Christian Mellinger.
