 Surveyed to William McKesson the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 1845, the above described tract of land containing one hundred and thirty three acres and fifty two perches and allowance of six per Cent. Situate adjoining lands of Robert McKesson, Francis Maloy and Andrew Dixon, in Centre township, Indiana County, and is composed of the Survey made this day to W<sup>m</sup> McKesson, By Virtue of his Warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1845, and a part of a Survey originally made 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1816 to Daniel McKesson, By Warrant dated 18<sup>th</sup> of January 1815, as represented in the above diagram by the dotted lines, enclosing the name "Robert McKesson" and "John Sherriden", which embraces the remainder of the Survey to Daniel McKesson-above recited.
