



A draft of a tract of land situate in lower Mount Bethel Township Northampton County containing Three hundred and ten acres one hundred and nine perches and the allowance of Six p Cent &c. Originally surveyed to Joseph Martin in two tracts viz. one of 92 acres 100 perches by Warrant dated the 9th Decem^r 1791. the other 218 acres 9 perches by Warrant dated the 4th April 1793. Resurveyed and divided the 25 March 1804 between the heirs of Joseph Martin deceased and the administrators of the said deceased's estate the part surveyed to the said heirs containing One hundred and eighty five acres eighty one perches & allowance of Six p cent. the part surveyed for the Administrators containing One hundred and twenty five acres, twenty eight perches & allowance aforesaid and is part of 150 acres Ordered by the Orphans Court to be sold the 14 January 1801 which sale was confirmed the 13 January 1802
