



The above described Tract of one hundred and thirty four acres & one hundred and sixty two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. is part of a larger tract of $392\frac{3}{4}$ of land situate in Southampton Township Franklin County (late Lurgan Township Cumberland County) which was resurveyed the 4th of August 1786 agreeable to an order of the Board of Property bearing date the 6th day of June 1786 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John McComb bearing date the 10th day of July 1752.

The above part was surveyed and divided off the 20th day of March 1786 by Matthew Henderson formerly a Deputy Surveyor, as appears by an Official Draft thereof remaining in my office, which Draft I have examined & find correct.
