Including the Venango Path and 15 Mile Spring on said Path. Situate North and West of the River-Ohio & Allegheny on the Waters of Pine Creek in District No 9. Called Millers Fancy Containing four hundred thirty eight acres and three quarters together with the usual allowance of Six P^c Cent for Roads
